Freedom Academy summer Instruction opportunities.

Due to budget restraints, summer instruction will have a different look this year.

Mr. Timothy and Mrs. Golding will be giving extended reading instruction opportunities to qualifying students with an IEP. IDEA has set the qualifying parameters for this program. Parents of those students will be directly contacted by Mr. Timothy and Mrs. Golding to arrange for dates and times.

In compliance with the Title I program, Miss. Ahlstrom is offering a school sponsored Summer Reading Camp for students who are below reading level in grades K-3. Teachers have been given flyers about the program to give to those students who would benefit from extra instruction. Those students can include Title I and IEP students. An IEP student may participate in both. A minimal fee for the cost of books will be charged, but should not prevent a student from attending. Options are available for a few who may need it.

Freedom Academy is researching the probability of an expanded summer program for 2012 in which all students would be invited to participate.
