Facts & Questions

What is this?

Trivia Night is an informal and fun competition where teams (tables) go against each other to see who has the greatest knowledge of all matters trivia. Our hosts will ask questions (they will be displayed on the big screen in the gymnasium) and tables discuss the best answer. We will have 10 rounds consisting of 10 questions each. Tables will answer the 10 questions on an answer sheet which will be turned in at the end of each round. The winner of the round will be announced and a new round will begin. In the case of a tie, a sudden death round will be played. At the end of the 10 rounds, a grand prize winning table will be announced. FYI – no electronic devices allowed to find answers!!

Why should we attend?

Trivia Nights are notoriously good fun for all involved. Putting the fun aside, all public schools need additional funds to run top notch programs, to provide beautiful & safe facilities, and to attract & keep the best of the best teachers and staff. Trivia Nights can produce substantial amounts of funds with little overhead; therefore, providing more funds for our school.

What should I bring?

Please bring your family and friends to Trivia Night. Make sure to reserve your table in advance to ensure a spot! That night, bring **cash** for snacks and to purchase mulligans!! We will also have a variety of silent auction items for you to outbid your friends.

What are mulligans?

Mulligans are free passes. Just like in golf, they will undo a wrong. In the case of Trivia Night, they will undo a wrong answer, giving you credit as if you answered the question correctly. Of course, you must purchase the mulligans for *\$2 each and can only purchase 2 per round*. The host will announce the round topic and then ask which tables would like to purchase mulligans. Your runner (a Jr. High student) will collect your money and give you a mulligan. Our Trivia Night mulligans will be stickers you can stick onto your answer sheet in place of an answer you believe to be wrong or unknown to your table.

How do I reserve a table?

You may reserve a table by paying at the front office of Freedom Preparatory Academy or you may pay on the school's website at www.pfa.cc. (Please pay online if possible) We encourage you to reserve an entire table for \$80; however, you may purchase individual seats for \$10. Individuals will be placed at tables with other individuals and then compete as a table of new friends!

If paying online:

- The "Online Payments" tab is found on the left column of the home page near the bottom
- Fill out all information as directed
- In the Notes field, state that your payment is for a Trivia Night table or individual(s)
 - o *If you are paying for an entire table* - give your table a name and name a table leader
